If you are responsible, enthusiastic and enjoy working with children, then we want you for March Break Camp!

March Break Camp (MBC) is a pre-registered educational program for children ages 5-14. Camp programs run from **March 12th – 16th** and are based on the Museum's exhibits and collections. Courses are led by one instructor and up to four volunteers who help the instructor deliver their program.

What do March Break Camp volunteers do?

Volunteers act as assistants to the course instructors.

Some of the ways they help are by:

- preparing material for activities
- facilitating children's activities
- helping with clean-up after activities
- assisting in escorting children through the Museum

How do I Apply?

Simply fill out the following form and return it by mail, e-mail or in person no later than **5:00 PM on Tuesday, February 21st, 2012**. Forms received after this date will not be processed and you will not be eligible to volunteer for the session. To provide everyone with a clear idea of how MBC works and what the role of a volunteer is, we are holding an **orientation/information session on Saturday, February 25th, from 1:30 PM – 5:30 PM**. **Attendance is mandatory**; you will not be contacted inviting you to the orientation. **Only those who attend orientation will be considered for a position**. Meet at the Staff Entrance on the south side of the Museum no earlier than 1:15 PM (between the ROM and the Planetarium).

Attendance at the orientation session does not guarantee a position with MBC. A complete application and a positive review at orientation are also necessary to gain a volunteer position. If you are not accepted as a volunteer for this session, your application will be kept on file and you will be notified of future opportunities.
