CANADIAN & WORLD STUDIES

GRADE 9

- **Out of the Earth! Minerals, Fossil Fuels, and Human Systems**

Investigate the interaction of human systems with the natural resources of the Earth's crust. Analyze real specimens and case studies to understand the impact and influence of natural resources in our everyday lives.

GRADE 10

- **Canadian History Since World War I**

From the trenches and battlefields in Europe to post-centennial year objects of the recent past, examine primary sources in our lab and galleries to understand how changes in culture and identity have shaped the last 100 years of Canadian history.

SCIENCE

GRADE 11

- **Evolution**

Early Humans - Handle replica skulls to compare the structural characteristics of early and modern humans, forming a model of trends in human evolution and the development of the primate family.

Biology - Investigate evolutionary processes through specimens in our galleries, and analyze real scientific evidence in our lab that explains the theory of evolution.

SOCIAL SCIENCES & HUMANITIES

GRADE 11

- **Introduction to Anthropology, Psychology, and Sociology**

Cultural Anthropology - Explore social group formation and behaviour, including rites of passage and gender roles, as well as the effects of urbanization, industrialization, and technology on groups.

Physical Anthropology - Handle replica hominid skulls to study human evolution, and consider when, how, and why early primates developed human characteristics. Examine the fossil record to reveal work, diet, and family structures.

GRADE 9 - 12

- **Of Africa: a survey of cultures and natural history**

Investigate the vibrant and diverse cultures and natural history of Africa through this multi-disciplinary guided tour. Analyze and reflect upon the varied expressions of African identity, the impact of European colonization, and the global reach of the African Diaspora.

Analyze authentic cultural objects representing a survey of First Peoples in Canada in our lab and galleries to understand Indigenous perspectives on our interconnectedness with the natural environment and other related issues.

GRADE 9-12

- **Ancient Greek Art**

Delve into the art of the Ancient Greeks in our galleries as it evolved from the second millennium B.C.E. to the Hellenistic period. Handle original artifacts to identify the characteristics and styles of the different periods.
