ARRIVAL at the ROM

All students should be dropped-off at the Queen's Park Cres. bus drop-off zone.

The school group entrance is on the South end of the Museum approximately 20 metres south of the bus drop-off zone.

School groups should *not* enter via the new main entrance on the North side of the Museum.

DIRECTIONS to the ROM

Construction Notice: From September 2007 to the end of 2009, Bloor St. will be partially closed between Avenue Rd. and Church St. due to water maintenance.

The Directions below are intended to help you avoid construction delays.

Highway 401:

- Exit the 401 at Avenue Rd. (exit #367).
- Drive South on Avenue Rd. to Bloor St. (30-45 minutes).
- Just south of Bloor St. pull into the bus drop-off zone on the right.

The Gardiner Expressway:

- Exit the Gardiner at Spadina Ave.
- Drive North on Spadina Ave. to Bloor St. (15-20 minutes)
- Turn right onto Bloor St. and Drive to Queen's Park Cres.
- Turn right onto Queen's Park Cres.
- Just south of Bloor St. pull into the bus drop-off zone on the right.

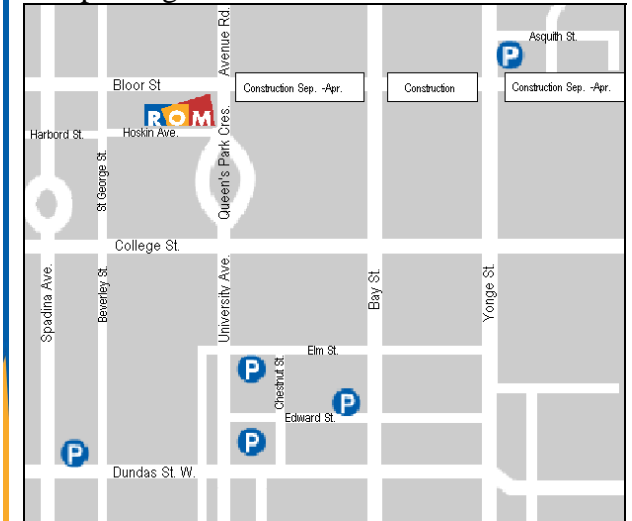
Highway 404 / The Don Valley Parkway:

Due to construction, do not exit the DVP at Bloor St.

- If possible exit the 404 at the 401 (exit #17, 401 Westbound) and follow the 401 Directions above.
- Or, continue south on the DVP to the Gardiner westbound and follow the Gardiner directions above.

PARKING for BUSES
