



#### **Preamble**

Royal Ontario Museum (ROM) is an agency of the Government of Ontario, a member of the international museum community, and one of Canada's leading cultural institutions. As such, ROM occasionally enters into formal relationships with governments, other institutions, and cultural groups. These associations are described in Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) and Formal Agreements. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that such agreements serve the interests of ROM and its stakeholders, now and in the future.

## **Policy**

ROM views formal relationships with other organizations and individuals as opportunities to engage in collaborative efforts to further ROM's realization of its mandate, vision, and mission.

ROM's policy on MOU's and Formal Agreements covers all binding agreements that commit the institution to significant long-term actions with regard to its primary activities, including collecting, research, exhibitions, programs, and publications. All such agreements must

- Include a renewal date, not to exceed a set term without Board approval, to
  ensure that ROM is free to adapt its policies and programs without restriction in
  the future.
- Be approved by the Board of Trustees.
- Be signed by both the Director & CEO and the Chair of the Board.

The following are excluded from this policy:

- Agreements that are project specific and thus limited in duration and impact.
- External contracts with third parties for the purpose of carrying out activities in the annual business plan.
- Agreements with donors and potential donors of funds and/or gifts- in-kind, which are governed by collections practices and ROM Foundation policies.
