Entrance

The Queen's Park Weston Entrance features a ramp and push button automatic doors. School groups may use the President's Choice School Entrance, located at the south end of the building on Queen's Park, which is equipped with an automatic door. This entrance can be accessed by a ramp with handrails also near the school entrance.

Entrance

All entrances feature an off-loading layby to drop off and pick up visitors with accessibility needs.

ROM has a board policy of Public Access and is a leader in implementing the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA).
