Chris Jamroz is CEO of STG Holdings LLC ('STG') and Executive Chairman of St. George Logistics, North America's fastest growing provider of specialty 3PL and transportation services critical to the global supply chain. As a leading logistics platform, STG is focused on the import/export supply chain and value-added warehousing and distribution.

He is Chairman of the Board of CMS Info Systems and an independent Director on the Board of its wholly-owned subsidiary SIPL, a Baring Private Equity Asia portfolio company and one of the largest secure logistics companies in the world, headquartered in Mumbai, India.

Chris also serves on the Board of Directors of Emergent Cold, an Elliott Management backed international specialty logistics provider focused on the global cold chain.

In 2018 Chris was nominated by the Prime Minister of Poland to represent the nation's economic interests in the United States as Chairman of the Polish Chamber of Commerce in the United States, based in Washington, DC.

Previously, Chris was President and COO of Garda Cash Logistics. Under Chris' transformational leadership, Garda became #1 currency supply chain, secure logistics and cash business services provider in North America. Prior to Garda, Chris was a top executive at one of the best-established investment banking groups, globally, as the Head of JPMorgan's corporate finance practice in Canada.

In 2016, Chris was appointed to Co-Chair Canada 150 Advisory Committee to oversee the preparations to celebrate the country's 150th anniversary of confederation.
