How do I Apply?

To provide everyone with a clear idea of how ROM Camp works and what the role of a volunteer is, we are holding an orientation/information session on Sunday, March 8th, 2020 from 10:30 PM – 1:30 PM. Attendance is mandatory; you will not be contacted inviting you to the orientation. Only those who attend orientation will be considered for a position. Meet at the Staff Entrance on the south side of the Museum no earlier than 10:15 AM (between the ROM and the Planetarium).
