



Dress for the Occasion

We're celebrating our 100th birthday with a ton of great programs at the Museum. And every party needs a party hat! Make your own featuring a special ROM design and wear it when you visit during our 100th year.

Here's what to do:

1. Print the hat template and cut out the shape along the solid black line. Trace the template onto construction paper and cut it out. This one will be your hat.
2. Hold both corners of the semicircle and wrap it into a cone shape, until the straight sides overlap, with the point where the big dot is.
3. Use a bit of glue or tape to hold the ends in place.
4. Choose your design and print that page.
5. Colour in the design and cut it out along the outer lines. Be sure to cut around the tabs. You'll need those to attach the design to your hat.
6. Bend each tab. Tape or glue the top tab (if your design has one) to the front of the hat. Tape or glue the bottom tab under the inside of the front of the hat.
7. If your design doesn't have a tab, cut along the straight line. Tape or glue the rings around the base of the hat.
8. Punch a hole on each side of your hat.
9. Cut two pieces of string or yarn and tie one through each hole.
10. Put on your hat and tie the string under your chin to keep it in place.

Let the party start!

Here's what you need:

Printer and plain white paper
Construction paper
Markers, crayons, or pencil crayons
Scissors
Tape or glue
String or yarn
Hole punch








Hat Template
